Following this, they submitted a 2-page whitepaper outlining how their technology addresses crucial National Security challenges, which contributed to 60% of their total score. The final step involved presenting their core technology to an esteemed judging panel comprising representatives from the Naval Undersea Warfare Center, Salve Regina University, Mitre, and an industry consultant, with this segment accounting for the remaining 20% of their score.

The presentations took place both in-person at our lab space in Middletown and virtually via Teams. Following the completion of all presentations, our esteemed judges engaged in thoughtful deliberation, and the scores were meticulously tallied.
